



## MUSKOGEE GUN CLUB RANGE RULES

IN BECOMING A MEMBER OF THE MUSKOGEE GUN CLUB, YOU ARE SIGNING THAT YOU HAVE READ THESE RULES AND THAT YOU WILL ABIDE BY THEM.

### FUNDAMENTAL SAFETY RULES

1. Always treat the gun as if it is loaded.
2. Never point a gun at something you're not prepared to destroy.
3. Never put your finger on the trigger until your sights are on the target.
4. Always be sure of your target and what is behind it.

### MEMBERSHIP RULES

1. A member must be at least 21 years old.
2. A membership includes your spouse and minor children (20yrs or under) living at home. A spouse can request their own membership card, but they must sign a waiver. Minor children are required to be accompanied by a member at ALL times, making sure all rules are followed.
3. Members can take a guest (age 21 or older) one time to the range. The member is responsible for the guest and must accompany them at all times, making sure all safety rules are followed.
4. The guest MUST sign a waiver and place in mailbox on Club house.
5. A membership allows only one family member to vote during a business meeting.

### RANGE GENERAL RULES

1. Shooting may begin at 8:00 am. Shooting ends at sunset.
2. **ALWAYS** lock the gate behind you after entering/leaving the range.
3. NEVER loan your gate key to anyone.
4. Membership ID's must be worn on the range at all times.
5. All ranges are COLD ranges. All guns must be unloaded when brought to the range.
6. Only PAPER targets allowed. Metal targets are provided by the Club. **NO GLASS BOTTLES!**
7. Paper targets should be placed on the target backboards provided by the club.
8. Shooting past red stakes with yellow tape on the pistol range is done at your own risk
9. No Alcoholic Beverages or Drugs are allowed on the property.
10. Be familiar with your weapon.
11. Wear appropriate eye & ear protection while firing.
12. Targets/target holders must stay at the base of the berm on pistol range & general-purpose range.
13. Firearms of unknown sight adjustment must be test fired at a distance of no greater than 25 yards.
14. When a firearm is uncased, actions must be open with the muzzle pointed down range or in a gun rack.

15. Shooters should call a CEASE FIRE before going down range to place targets or to check targets
16. Each shooter on the line must open the action of their firearm and insert a chamber flag or leave the bolt fully open to the rear and then not touch the firearm until the range is clear of all shooters.
17. All firing must be directed at a target in front of your firing position. No cross firing from stations.

### NOT ALLOWED

1. No exploding targets, incendiary tracer, 50 BMG or armor piercing rounds.
2. No fully automatic firearms or semi-auto firearms with added equipment that allows firearm to simulate a fully automatic firearm such as slide fire stocks, bump firing or binary triggers.
3. No center fire rifles or center fire RIFLE ammunition allowed on the pistol range.
4. Hunting on Muskogee Gun Club property is prohibited.

I HAVE READ ABOVE RULES AND HAVE VERBALLY DISCUSSED SAME WITH THE CHIEF RANGE OFFICER AND WILL COMPLY WITH RULES.
